Family Planning for Transgender and Gender Expansive People—New Study Funded!

We are excited to announce that [Ibis Reproductive Health](#), in collaboration with [The PRIDE Study](#) Co-Director Dr. Juno Obedin-Maliver, Dr. Jen Hastings of Planned Parenthood and UCSF, and Cale Stoeffler of Planned Parenthood received a grant from the Society of Family Planning Research Fund to study the family planning needs and experiences of transgender and gender expansive folks in the United States.
