**Happy LGBTQIA+ History Month and National Coming Out Day!**

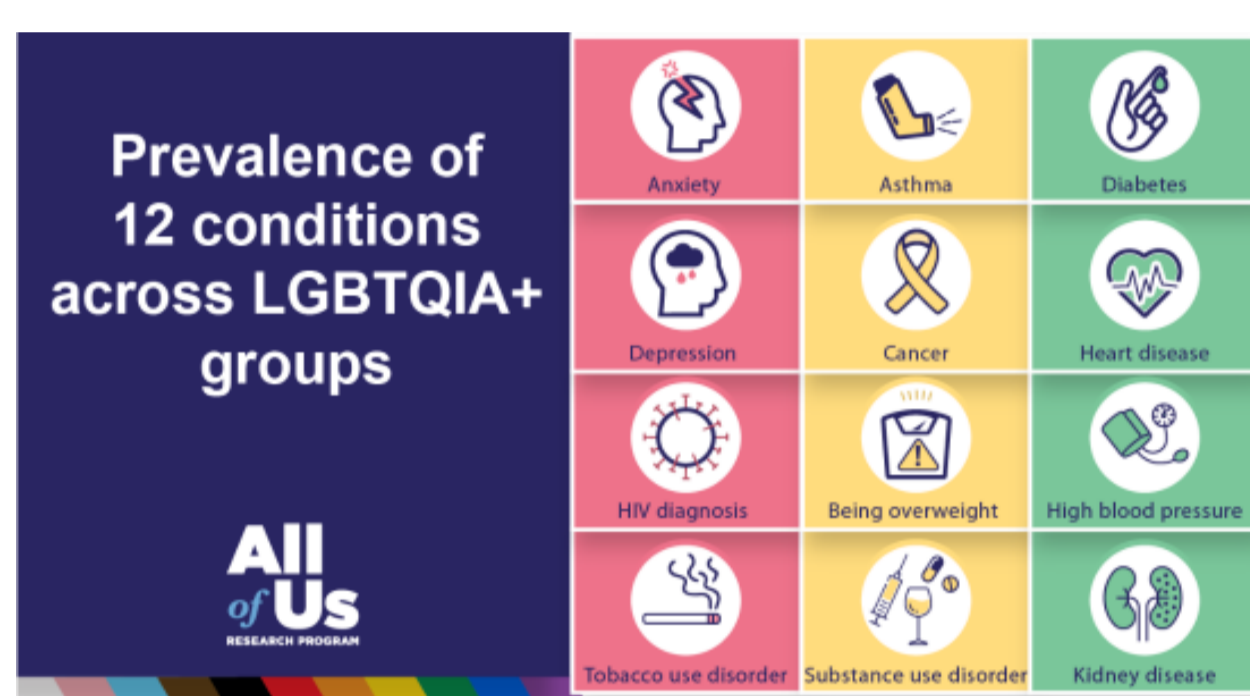

**Publication #1: Common Health Conditions among LGBTQIA+ People in the All of Us Research Program**

This is one of the first studies to examine the health of LGBTQIA+ individuals in the *All of Us* Research Program, which has one of the largest samples of LGBTQIA+ people in the United States. We also show that using data from *All of Us* has the potential to improve healthcare for LGBTQIA+ communities. This is because the program combines data from various sources, allowing for a better understanding of LGBTQIA+ communities and their unique health experiences.

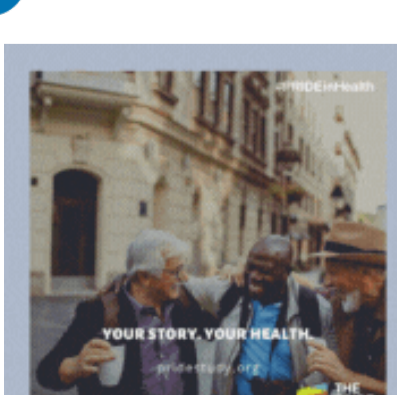
