



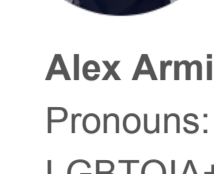

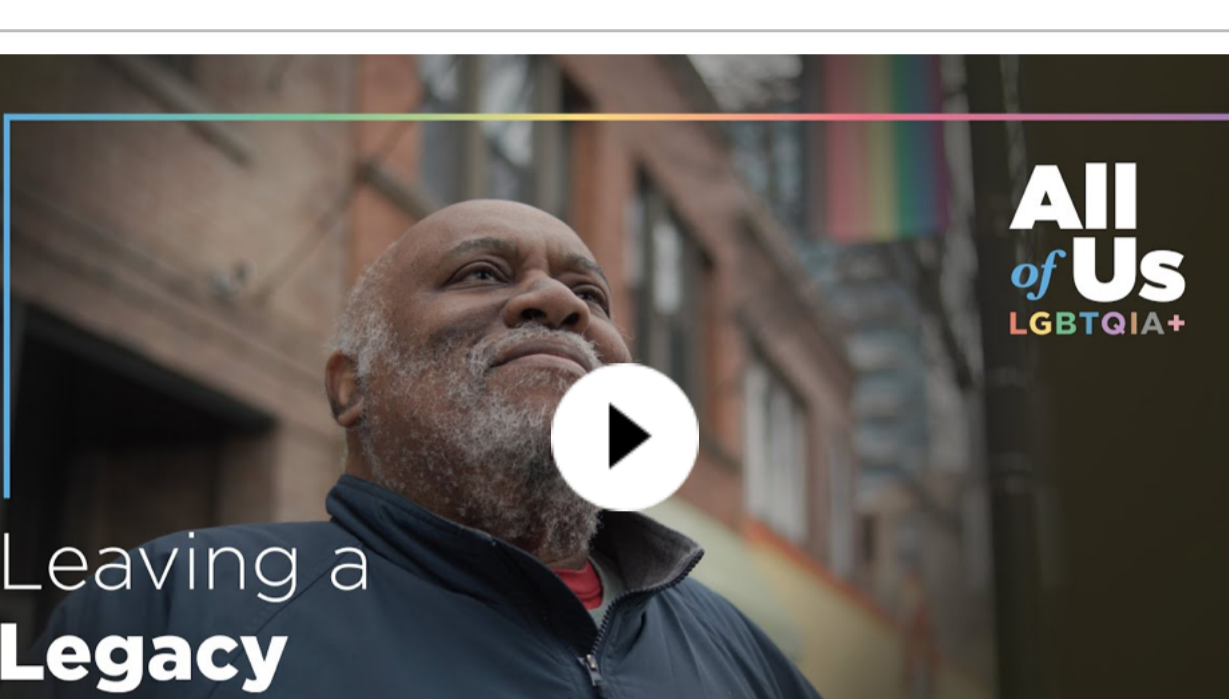

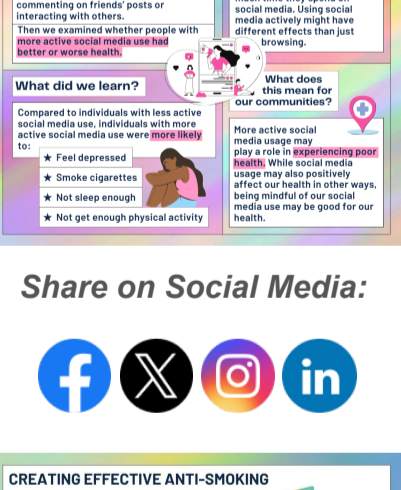

This was one of the first studies to measure how much LGBTQIA+ people use social media actively, not just how much time they spend on social media. Using social media actively might have different effects than just browsing.

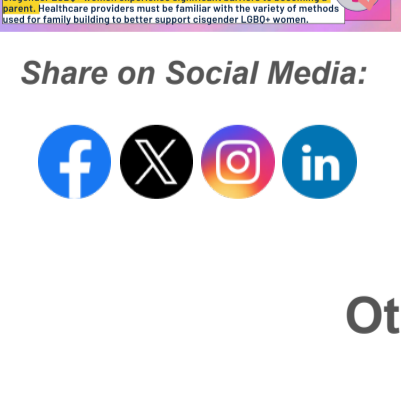

**Publication #46: Creating Effective Anti-Smoking Messages for LGBTQ+ Young Women**

Our study was one of the first about helping to quit smoking that focused specifically on young adult LGBTQ+ women, as there is a gap in knowledge of effective strategies for this group. Our study is more inclusive by recruiting both cisgender and transgender women participants.

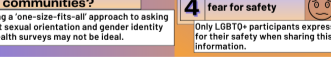


**Publication #47: How Cisgender LGBTQ+ Women Became Parents and Built Their Families**

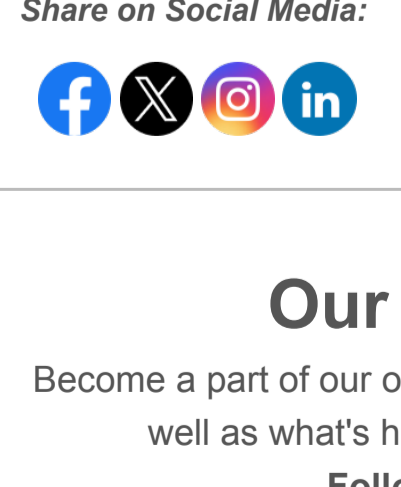
This was one of the first studies about family building that included all cisgender women who self-identified as LGBTQ+ in our study. Many previous studies on family building have been limited to cisgender women in same-sex couples. This excluded a large proportion of the community, such as cisgender LGBTQ+ women parents who are single and who are in partnerships with transgender and cisgender men.

**Publication #1: How people prefer to be asked about their sexual orientation and gender identity on health surveys**

This was one of the first studies that explored how both cisgender heterosexual people and LGBTQIA+ people want to be asked about sexual orientation and gender identity on health surveys and how these groups compare. We had a diverse group of participants by age, sexual orientation and gender identity, race and ethnicity, and from rural, urban, and suburban settings across the U.S.

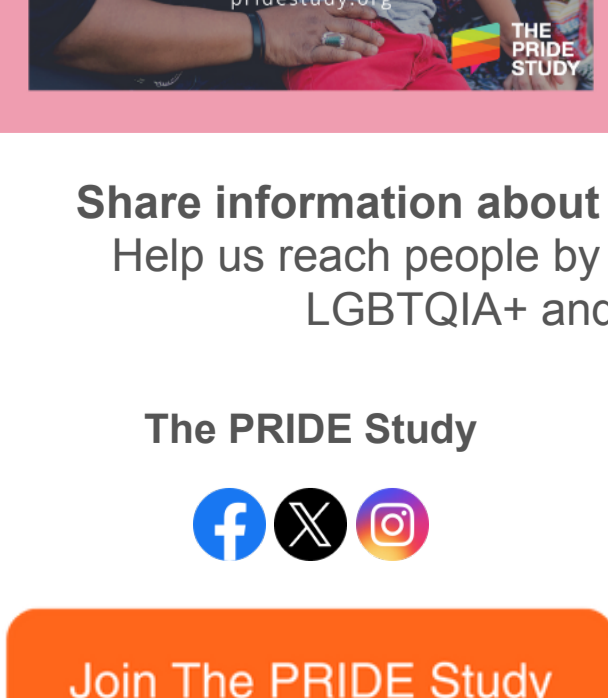
